Costa Brava Hospice

Dying may well be the most important stage in the life of a person. This is the stage when many needs must be attended to, including, above all, the spiritual needs of the dying person.

Professional healthcare workers and other people in attendance at this time grow close to the dying person and their family. Many of us feel daunted by our lack of training and resources to deal with the situation. We find ourselves face to face with death, and we can feel at a loss as to how to help the dying person, from a lay spiritual perspective.

This workshop is designed to raise awareness of our own spiritual reality and from there to learn how to provide appropriate support for the dying person.

- The dying process. The physical aspect. The non-physical aspect.
- · Connecting with our own mortality.
- · Our own beliefs about death.
- Transcendence.
- Our own experiences of death.
- NDE (near-death experiences) and scientific research.
- Practical session. Bodywork.
